- Informative/promotional programmes on TV and social media






PNS Industrial Support Programme



Major R&D Areas

- Crop Improvement: New varieties/ Genetic modifications
- Bio-saline Agriculture/Nutrient Management: Technologies/Processes
- Insect Pest Management: Bio-control, SIT, Pesticide residue
- Industrial Biotech: Enzymes/ Bio-leaching/Biofertilizer
- Analytical Services: Testing for wheat, rice, sugarcane, food & feed products, animal vaccines, environment studies, etc.
