

ABOUT INSC

- Founded on 11th November 1990 by the INSG.
- Divided into 5 Regions
- Member Societies represent more than 100,000 nuclear professionals.
- Acts as global forum for Nuclear Societies to discuss and establish common aims and goals.
- Holds the Non-Governmental Organization Observer Status in IAEA and UNEP.



INSC Objectives

- To be a global forum for Nuclear Societies to discuss and establish common aims and goals.
- To act as a global Non-Governmental Organization in nuclear matters of international nature.
- To represent the views and positions of professionals and workers in the nuclear field through their Nuclear Societies.
- To value the work and achievements of the nuclear community of the world based on ethical principles adopted by the Nuclear Societies.
- To increase the operational efficiency of Nuclear Societies by establishing means for cooperation and complementation in the execution of their programs.



Governance

- General Assembly (GA):
 - Meets once a year
 - Open to anyone from Member Societies
 - Only accredited Delegates from Member Societies vote
 - Final Decision maker of the Council
 - In addition, Delegates meet once more during the year between the months of April and July

• Executive Committee

- Consist of Chair, 1st and 2nd Vice Chairs, Secretary, Immediate Past Chair, and Non-Voting Treasurer
- Treasurer elected/re-affirmed every year at the GA
- Each Voting member represents each of the 5 Regions of INSC
- Carries out day-to-day activities of INSC
- Meets at least 4 times a year, mostly virtually
